This theme invites artists to reflect on what community means to them and propose artwork that celebrates this theme and promotes an exceptional quality of life. Proposals will be selected through a jury process.***

## ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

Framed 2D artwork must come "hang ready" for a single wire system.

Matted 2D works may use Velcro (provided by the artist).

D-rings will not be accepted hanging techniques for this display system.

3D works need to provide their own pedestal (black or white only - in good condition).

Artists, and their volunteers, are responsible for installing and deinstalling the work.

NRH Cultural Arts Coordinator will be available for assistance.

Installation: Monday, March 3 from 1pm-4pm.

Opening Reception: Thursday, March 6 from 5:30pm-7pm.

Deinstallation: Monday, April 21 from 11am-3pm.
